## **BIG NAME CONCERT HEADLINERS HELP KEEP CHESAPEAKE BAY IN HARMONY**

On Sunday, **Sammy Kershaw** caps off the weekend with two decades of country music. Military audiences and civilians alike are sure to enjoy his chart topper "Red, White & Blue", as well as numerous other hits including "Cadillac Style", "She Don't Know She's Beautiful" and "Queen of My Double-Wide Trailer". Performance time begins at 3:30 p.m.
